

CONWAY VILLAGE FIRE DISTRICT
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' MEETING
Thursday, March 24, 2022, 7:00 A.M.
Admin. Building

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 A.M.

Commissioners present: Steve Bamsey, Mike Digregorio and Tom Buco
Staff present: Amy Snow - Municipal Bookkeeper, Chief Solomon and Superintendent Vallieres.

FIRECHIEF'S BUSINESS

The Chief stated that he had met with Chief Preece and Conway Police Chief Mattei; the three of them then met with the Conway Selectmen and \$139,000 of ARPA funds were authorized to upgrade the radio system. Discussion ensued.

SUPERINTEDEDENT'S BUSINESS

Bruno mentioned that he too would be contacting the selectmen regarding funds for certain needed sewer and water upgrades.

He then offered that he has been ordering supplies for the summer projects as future orders could have a tremendous lead time. He stated that he recently ordered 3, 60-foot lengths of ductile iron pipe that won't be delivered until October 2022. After October there could be up to a 5 year wait. Discussion ensued.

Bruno said that he had again been contacted by Virginia Schrader. Virginia, along with Paul Cail, both from the Career/Technical Center would like to take a walk and observe what needs to be done to rehab the gazebo roof. Discussion ensued.

BOOKKEEPERS BUSINESS

Amy first presented a request from Upper Saco Valley Land Trust, for use of the Park in July. They want to have an open house with the use of a tent. The Chief advised that there is irrigation all around the building: stakes cannot be used, ballast would be needed. They will need a permit to put up the tent and if the tent is greater than 10' x10' it needs to be inspected by the Fire Chief. **Mr. Bamsey made a motion to approve the use of the Park by the Upper Saco Valley Land Trust for the weekend of July 8th through the 10th. Seconded by Mr. Buco. Motion passed 3-0-0.**

Amy said that yesterday she received a call from Tim Quint, he is on the town preservation committee and would like to attend next week's meeting. The committee wants to preserve the Baker Upholstery building on Greenwood Avenue. They want to move it to our Main Street Park. He will be here next week to request/discuss this possibility.

ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS

Mr. Bamsey made a motion to ratify a., b., c., and d. Seconded by Mr. Digregorio.

- a. Ratify Payroll Manifest and sign checks for week ending 3/20/2022
- b. Ratify A/P Manifest dated 3/23/22 and sign checks dated 3/25/2022

Discussion: Town of Conway – Trust Fund transfers in the amount of \$281,938.

FW WEBB – Manhole cover and a Hydrant pump. Discussion ensued

Motion passed 3-0-0.

Mr. Bamsey made a motion to approve the chief's timesheet for week ending 3/20/2022, seconded by Mr. Digregorio. Motion passed 3-0-0.

Mr. Bamsey made a motion to approve the minutes for week 3/18/2022, seconded by Mr. Digregorio. Motion passed 3-0-0.

Discussion ensued regarding the curbing and parking in the park parking lot next and parking behind the fire station.

Mr. Bamsey requested that a flyer be added to the next quarter bills pertaining to the Informational Meeting regarding the possible future dissolution of the district.

The next meeting will be Thursday, March 31, 2022, at 5:00 P.M. in the Commissioners meeting Room.

The Informational Meeting regarding dissolving the district will take place on April 21, 2022, at 5:30 P.M.

There being no further business to come before the Board, meeting was adjourned without objection at 7:53 A.M.
