Meeting was called to order at 5:00 P.M.

Commissioners present: Steve Bamsey, Mike Digregorio and Tom Buco.  
Staff present: Amy Snow - Municipal Bookkeeper, Chief Solomon, and Superintendent Vallieres.

FIRE CHIEF'S BUSINESS

The Chief stated that the new Assistant Fire Chief has been working as a part time fire fighter for 7 years and after doing the math he requests 2 weeks' vacation to start. **Mr. Bamsey made the motion to increase the vacation time as recommended by the Chief. Seconded by Mr. Digregorio. Motion passed 3-0-0**

The last part for the new truck should be shipping tomorrow.

SUPERINTENDENT'S BUSINESS

Bruno stated that they have been working on the C Street to D Street loop connection, Farrington Ave., and meter replacements. Discussion ensued.

The Chief offered that Avesta Housing is planning on breaking ground any day.

Mr. Bamsey added that the gazebo had been repaired. Bruno stated that it's good for now.

BOOKKEEPER'S BUSINESS

Amy started by asking if the commissioners had received the email that she had sent regarding the NH Retirement System audit? If not, she will resend. There still seems to be email issues.

She then stated that she had emailed the AARP Community Challenge Grant denial letter. They thanked us for our recent application, unfortunately our organization has not been selected for funding at this time.

Amy asked for consideration on an abatement for the Radio Station Condominiums in the amount of \$81.37. She then explained some of the complications of online billing. **Mr. Buco made a motion to approve the abatement. Seconded by Mr. Digregorio. Motion passed 3-0-0.**

Mr. Digregorio asked if we can simply put a link on our website home page with step-by-step instructions. Amy said, yes, she can and will do that.
