The meeting was called to order at 5:00 P.M.

Commissioners present: Etienne Vallee, Mike DiGregorio, and Steve Bamsey
Staff present: Superintendent Bruno Vallieres, Bookkeeper Amy Snow and Chief Solomon.

Administrative Business

Mr. Bamsey made the motion to ratify a., & b. Seconded by Mr. Vallee.

- b. Ratify A/P Manifest dated 5/18/23 and sign checks dated 5/19/23.

Discussion:

Mr. Bamsey made a motion to approve the meeting minutes dated 5/11/2023. Seconded by Mr. Vallee. Motion passed 3-0-0.

Superintendent's Business

Bruno stated that they were working on lining people up to work on the pump stations. Towle Road got a new Mag meter.

Bruno then explained that, as he was asked last week, he had visited 6 Main Street and checked out the water tank leak. Discussion ensued.

Mr. Vallee made a motion to take this abatement request off the table and bring it back for consideration by the commissioners. Seconded by Mr. Digregorio.

Mr. Vallee made a motion to approve the Sewer Usage abatement for 6 Main St. in the amount of \$683.02. Motion failed 0-3-0.

Fire Chief's Business

Bookkeeper's Business

She then stated that the application for the Congressional District Spending has been sent in, now we're just waiting on the final ok. One RFQ (Request for Quote) has been received so far, the deadline is Friday.

Amy said that she saw Jason Dennis in court yesterday and he will be here on the 25th. She added that we received a call yesterday from 271 West Main Street and said that she had left her outside spicket on Thursday until Friday morning. Amy will call and explain the customers' options.

Next, she presented another abatement request at 164 West Main Street. Andrew went and looked at it and there is a picture. There was a leak before the deduct meter and you can see the wall was all wet. Andrew inspected it, it was wet, and the freeze plate was broken.

Mr. Vallee made a motion to approve the abatement for 164 West Main Street, Conway in the amount of \$255.52. Seconded by Mr. Digregorio. Motion passed 3-0-0.

Mr. Digregorio offered an update on the Gazebo improvements. He said he had finally made contact with Paul Cail and Paul was going to go take a peek at it. They're interested. He may take it on as a summer project on his own or wait till fall and get the kids involved, I'm not really sure. Mr. Digregorio made him aware of the budget.
